

Year 11 Mock Exams

As you know, **Year 11** will be sitting their next set of mock examinations as they prepare for their final GCSE examinations in the summer of 2025.

Examination success only comes as a result of thorough preparation and revision.

- It is important you attend all your mock exams. Any prospective colleges will want to know your results and your teachers will be predicting your grades on the strength of this performance. Avoid making any appointments during this mock window, where possible.
- There is no study leave, if you are not in an exam, you must attend your normal timetabled lessons.
- Subject teachers have been sharing revision resources and ideas during lessons.
- Students who have access arrangements (e.g. extra time, use of a laptop etc.) for external exams will have the same arrangement in these mock exams.
- All devices are prohibited in these mocks: Mobile phones, watches, ear pods, earphones, iPods etc. MUST be placed in your bag or handed in at the start of the exam for safe keeping.
- Students must be silent in the exam room, face the front when seated and must not communicate with other students in any way. All malpractice incidents will be reported to the Senior Leadership Team and parents will be informed.
- Students must supply all of their own equipment.

 2 black pens, 2 pencils, compass, protractor, ruler, eraser and calculator) and bring it to the examination in a clear plastic bag or pencil case.

A calculator is being promoted on exam board websites (CASIO Fx-991 EX CLASSWIZ non-programmable calculator); it is advisable that you buy one for use in both internal and external examinations.

Please do not rely on school to provide the equipment needed for the mock exams.
