Exam Content:

- Tectonic processes:
 - Geological timescales
 - Tectonic processes including the structure of the Earth and tectonic plates
 - Volcano types and features
 - Why people live near volcanoes
 - Volcanic monitoring predicting and planning
 - Earthquake causes and effects
 - Earthquake monitoring predicting and planning
 - Examples of earthquakes in areas of contrasting wealth
- Population:
 - Factors influencing the distribution of population
 - Factors affecting population growth & structures within countries
 - Factors people consider when migrating, categorised into push and pull factors
 - Impacts of migration on a named host and source country

Suggested Activities:

- Mind map - write down as much as you can remember about particular sub-topics
- REDO of exam/assessment questions in your book, including from your end of topic tests.
- Key word tests - write down as many key terms as you can, giving specific definitions and examples of where they have come from and where they are found in your content e.g. Restoration, Commonwealth, plantations, Middle Passage

Materials to use:

- Exercise books - these contain all your key materials and topics which you will need and will be assessed on. Take time to look at the materials on Teams to check you have all the finished content possible.
- In particular, focus on your SKILLS and PREVIOUS ASSESSMENTS - look at how you have done on these skills previously and the feedback you were given and PRACTICE AT LEAST ONE of them again, trying to perfect it this time!
- Knowledge Organisers - these are glued into your book but I have also placed these in Teams. You can utilise these to support your revision, starting with a task from memory and then using the KO as a way of filling in the blanks. Great for key words too!
